About The Program

The District offers a two-year course of study leading to the Associate of Science (A.S.) degree. This degree program is designed for students who plan to complete their first two years of college work at Wayne County Community College District and transfer to a baccalaureate degree granting institution. Students should contact a counselor for specific transfer requirements. Contact a transfer coordinator at the campus concerning specific course requirements that should be met.

Admission Requirements

The requirements for the Associate of Science degree, with the exception of the Natural Science group requirements, are the same as the Associate of Arts. A student must complete a minimum of 60 semester hours of credit, 15 of which must be earned at WCCCD. Course work must be completed with a grade of "C" or better.

General Education Requirements

English 6 Semester Hours

Social Science 9 Semester Hours

Courses must be taken in more than one academic discipline. At least two courses or six semester hours must be from the following:

- Anthropology
- Economics
- History
- Geography
- Labor Studies
- Political Science
- Psychology
- Sociology
- African-American Studies
- Muslim World Studies

Natural Science 20 Semester Hours

Courses must be taken in more than one of the following academic disciplines.

- Mathematics courses numbered 155 or above.
- Anthropology 153
- Biology
- Chemistry
- Physics
- Consult a counselor for other course options.

Humanities 9 Semester Hours

Courses must be taken in more than one of the following academic disciplines:

- Dance
- English (200 level)
- French
- Humanities
- Music
- Philosophy
- Spanish
- Speech

One course may be taken from the following courses:

- ENG 260, ENG 261, HIS 151, HIS 152, HIS 249, HIS 250, MWS 102 or ENG 212.

American Government Requirement 3 Semester Hours

Any courses used to fulfill this requirement may also be applied toward the Social Science Group Requirement.
