The median annual wage for network and computer systems administrators was \$81,000 in April 2017.

JOB OUTLOOK

Employment of network and computer systems administrators is projected to grow 6 percent from 2016 to 2026, about as fast as the average for all occupations. Growth will be highest at firms that provide cloud computing technology.

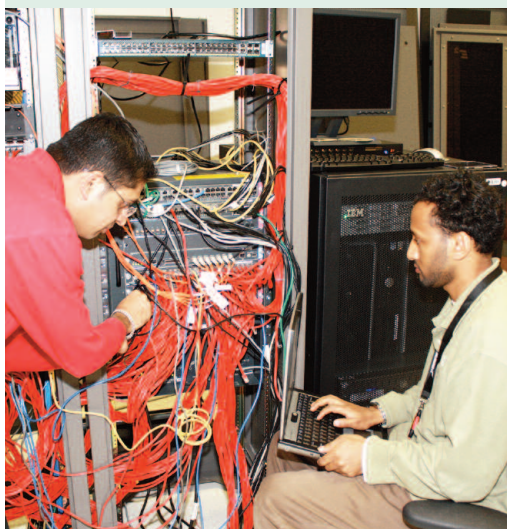


WHAT DO NETWORK ADMINISTRATORS DO?

Network and computer systems administrators are responsible for the day-to-day operation of an organization's computer networks. They organize, install, and support an organization's computer systems, including local area networks (LANs), wide area networks (WANs), network segments, intranets, and other data communication systems.

WHERE DO THEY WORK?

Network and computer systems administrators work with the physical computer networks of a variety of organizations and therefore are employed in many industries.

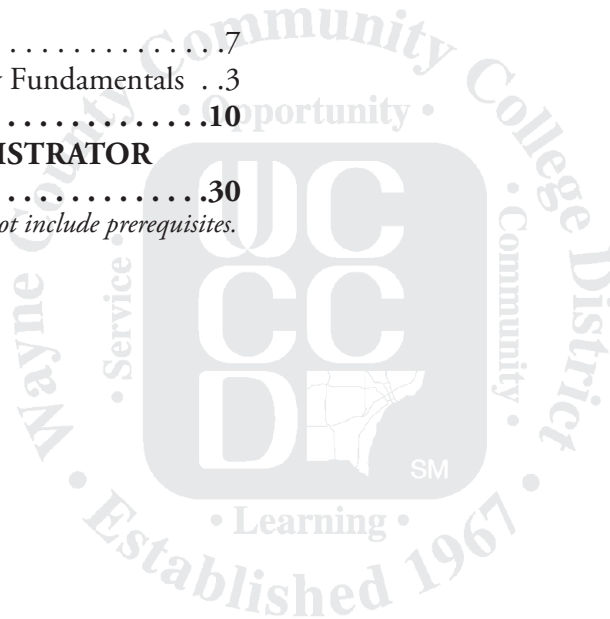
