2009-2010 Emancipated Minor/Legal Guardianship Verification

On your 2009-2010 *Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)*, you answered “Yes” to either question 56, which asked “Are you or were you an emancipated minor as determined by a court in your state of legal residence?” or question 57, which asked “Are you or were you in legal guardianship as determined by a court in your state of legal residence?”

In order for our Financial Aid Office to determine your eligibility for financial aid you must provide documentation of your status. Listed below are the required documents to qualify for an Emancipated Minor/Legal Guardianship.

- I am or I was an Emancipated Minor.** Check this box only if:
 - a) You can provide a copy of a court’s decision that as of today you are an emancipated minor, **or**
 - b) You can provide a copy of a court’s decision that were an emancipated minor immediately before you reached the age of being an adult in your state.
 To answer Yes to a) and b), the court must be located in your state of legal residence at the court’s decision was issued. **Attach documentation of a court’s decision of your emancipated minor status.**

- I am or I was in Legal Guardianship.** Check this box only if:
 - a) You can provide a copy of a court’s decision that you are in legal guardianship, **or**
 - b) You can provide a copy of a court’s decision that you are in legal guardianship immediately before you reached the age of being an adult in your state.
 To answer Yes to a) and b), the court must be located in your state of legal residence at the court’s decision was issued. **Attach documentation of if a) a copy of the Letters of Guardianship or the court’s or if b) a copy of the court’s Order of Discharge from Guardianship.**

- I answered my FAFSA incorrectly.**
 - I am still a minor and the court decision is no longer in effect.
 - The court decision was not in effect at the time I became an adult.**If this answer applies to you, you must correct your FAFSA by providing your parent(s) financial information. You and one parent must sign the FAFSA and submit your corrections to the Department of Education for processing.**
