HONORS CEREMONY

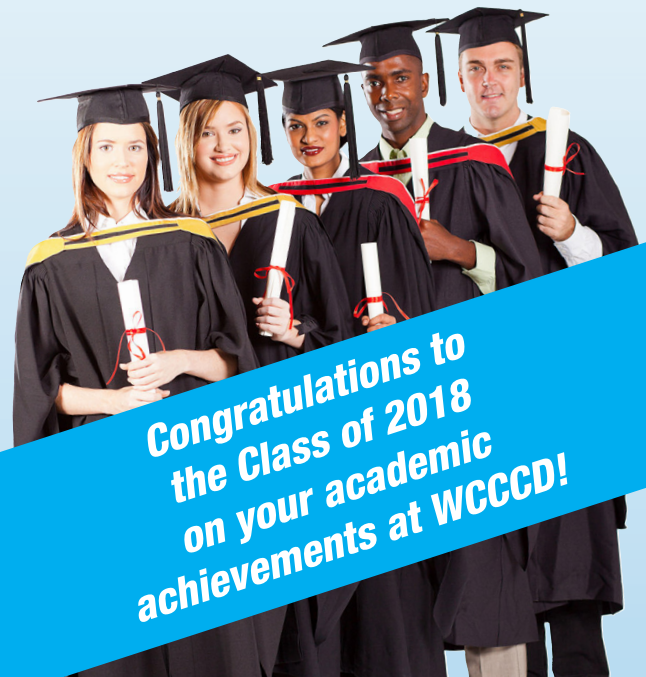
