Interested student-candidates must be recommended by his/her Wayne County Community College District (WCCCD) science professor and demonstrate proof (i.e. unofficial transcripts) of at least an overall 3.0 GPA out of a possible 4.0 GPA point system in his/her biology courses: BIO 165, BIO 240, BIO 250, BIO 252, and BIO 295.

Regular Membership inductees will receive the following items: certificate, membership card, honor cord, key chain, and decals. Membership fee is \$50.

### ***Membership Qualifications:***

Upon applying, students must meet Regular Membership qualifications:

- 1.** Student must have completed at least one term of the second year curriculum or its equivalent
- 2.** Student must have completed at least three semester courses in biological science of which at least one is not an introductory course, with an average grade of B or its equivalent in those biology courses
- 3.** Student must have a B average in all courses
- 4.** Student must be in good academic standing
