COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This course explores the potentials working with various media with emphasis on drawing, value, perspective, rendering, proportion, color, and composition. All of the subject matter areas including still life, the figure and landscape are explored. Greater emphasis on personal expression.

PREREQUISITES: ART 102

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon completion of this course, the student will be familiar with:

- Developing advance basic concepts of drawing as a practice and language.
- Developing a sense of conceptualizing and verbalizing concerns in art through critiques.
- Introducing new materials in drawing.
- Exercising critical judgment skills.
- Building or enhancing a vocabulary of art terminology.
- Influential artists and artistic movements.
- Attaining a better understanding of their abilities in drawing.
- Create a body of work.
