COURSE SYLLABUS

SUR 102 Central Service Lab and Clinical

CREDIT HOURS: 4.00

CONTACT HOURS: 180.00

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

In this course, students will be taught and tests on the following skills required for certification of a central service technicians: cleaning; decontamination; processing (inspection, assembling, and packaging) and sterilization of reusable patient care central services supplies and equipment; and distribution of these supplies and equipment to the units that require them. Students will be in the laboratory setting for the first four weeks of the course. In the final 11 weeks of the course, students will be placed at a clinical site working eight hours a day, two days a week. Students are responsible for their own transportation to the clinical sites.

PREREQUISITES: *SUR 100, SUR 101*

EXPECTED COMPETENCIES:

Upon successful completion of this course, the student will:

- Perform the duties of a central service technician according to professional standards
- Observe safety hazards to self and co-workers while performing duties.
- Demonstrate skill in all levels of clinical setting under the direct supervision of instructor or central service personnel.
- Demonstrate skill in all levels of the clinical setting under the direct supervision of an instructor or central service personnel.
- Develop and maintain a daily log recording all activities performed in the clinical setting.
- Maintain a clinical competency checklist and perform all expected job responsibilities at a 100 percent level of performance.

ASSESSMENT METHODS:

Student performance may be assessed by examination, quizzes, case studies, oral conversation, group discussion, oral presentations. The instructor reserves the option to employ one or more of these assessment methods during the course.
