Wayne County Community College District (WCCCD) has re-energized its Dual/Concurrent Enrollment Program by establishing stronger partnerships with students, parents, and high school districts throughout the 32 cities and townships that are part of the District's service area. As a result, the District continues to service record numbers of Dual/Concurrent enrolled students.

WCCCD's Dual/Concurrent Enrollment Program is designed to make college education more accessible to high school students so they can achieve their educational/career goals while saving both time and money.

Dual/Concurrent Enrollment allows qualifying high school students the opportunity to begin their college studies prior to high school graduation. Whether students plan to enroll in a career/technical program, achieve an Associates degree or earn a baccalaureate degree, Dual/Concurrent Enrollment will provide students an opportunity to begin earning college credit.

Program Diversity:

The District's five campuses are located in industrial, suburban and metropolitan areas where a major share of Michigan's technical and skilled occupations are located. Because of the diversity of its service areas, WCCCD places a strong emphasis on occupational and career programs as well as traditional college and university transfer programs, including those within the liberal arts discipline.

The District currently offers more than 90 programs leading to either an associate degree or certificate in various disciplines.

This brochure was created to provide our educational community with information about the Dual/Concurrent enrollment program requirements, expectations and services.

Dual/Concurrent Enrollment and Home School Student-Admission Procedures

A home school student is defined as a student who is not completing his/her secondary education at a state of Michigan or state approved school. This student is usually taught by a parent or teacher in the home.

- Home School students age 14-17 are eligible to apply for admission to Wayne County Community College District.
- This student and parent should be referred to a Student Services Advisor/Counselor.

Required documents for admission:

- ✓ WCCCD APPLICATION
- ✓ Complete COMPASS Testing/include score results
- ✓ Dual/Concurrent Enrollment Application
- ✓ Submit a copy of their home school transcripts each semester

All documents for both home school and dual/concurrent students must be forwarded to the District Student Services Office for approval. Students must see an Advisor/Counselor each semester he/she is enrolled.

The WCCCD Dual/Concurrent Enrollment Application must be completed each semester.
