

Dental Hygiene

Upon completion of the Dental Hygiene program, graduates are eligible to take the National Board Dental Hygiene Examination (NBDHE) and the Commission on Dental Competency Assessment-Western Regional Examining Board-Council of Interstate Testing (CDCA-WREB-CITA). After successful completion of these examinations' graduates are eligible to apply for licensure through the State of Michigan or 49 other jurisdictions. Once licensure is received, WCCCD dental hygiene graduates may obtain employment as a licensed Registered Dental Hygienist.
