## Student Outcomes

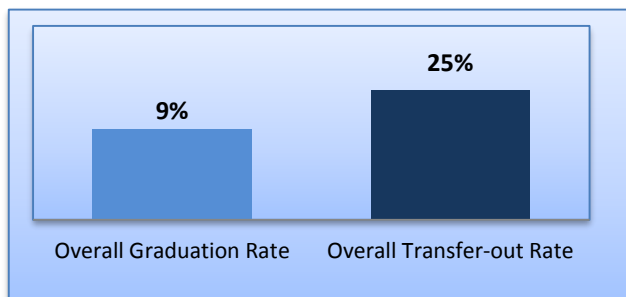
Pursuant to the Higher Education Opportunity Act (HEOA) of 2008, Wayne County Community College District (WCCCD) must make available the following student outcomes data to current and prospective students.

### Retention (Fall to Fall)

WCCCD's retention rate for *first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking students* is 42%. This is the percentage of first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking students who began their studies in fall 2015 and returned in fall 2016.

### Institutional Graduation and Transfer-out Rate

The graduation and transfer-out rates below indicate the percentage of *first-time, full-time, certificate or degree-seeking students* who complete an associate's degree or certificate at WCCCD in three years and those who transfer-out to another college or university within those same three years.



- **WCCCD's 4-year average "Student-Right-to-Know" completion or graduation rate (total completers within 150% - 3 years) is 9%**
- **WCCCD's 4 year average "Student-Right-to-Know" transfer-out rate (total completers within 150% - 3 years) is 25%**

Although the District is required to provide students with data on the number of first-time, full-time enrollments who complete a certificate or degree at the District within 3 years, many students take longer to graduate than this and many other students attend WCCCD for various educational, professional, and personal reasons.

### Student Body Diversity

WCCCD's commitment to diversity is rooted in its core values. These values guide the District in creating a teaching and learning environment where students from diverse backgrounds are able to learn from and about each other.

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### Job Placements Obtained by Graduates

WCCCD conducts annual surveys of our graduates. According to the 2015-2016 New Graduate Exit Survey:

- 77% of the respondents held their current job prior to graduation.
- 39% are employed in the Health/Human Services Industries, 34% in Business, and 10% in Education/Government Industries.
