Washburn has won 19 ASCAP Awards for Adventurous Programming from the League of American Orchestras, as well as The American Prize in Orchestral Conducting, professional division in 2013, and the American Prize Ernst Bacon Memorial Award for the Performance of American Music, professional division in 2016.
