MICUP Applications Are Now Available

The Michigan College and University Partnership Transfer Transition Program is a collaborative effort between three Michigan community colleges (Delta College, Grand Rapids Community College, and Wayne County Community College District) and Michigan Tech.

The goals of the program are:

1. To encourage students to pursue careers in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) fields
2. To spark students' interest in research
3. To significantly increase the transfer of underrepresented ethnic minority, first-generation, and economically disadvantaged students from community colleges to four-year institutions.

Students must:

- Complete MICUP Application before deadline February 9, 2018
- Obtain faculty signature **AND** letter of recommendation
- Enclose 1 unofficial transcript
- Write statement of intent
- Provide applicant's signature
- Submit a photocopy of Permanent Residency card if needed
- Have a minimum of 2.8 GPA, currently enrolled, and have completed a minimum of 24 credits
- Be a US citizen or permanent resident
- Be enrolled in a Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics (STEM) field of study
- Be available for the internship May 11 – June 30, 2018
