### ***HONORS CEREMONY***

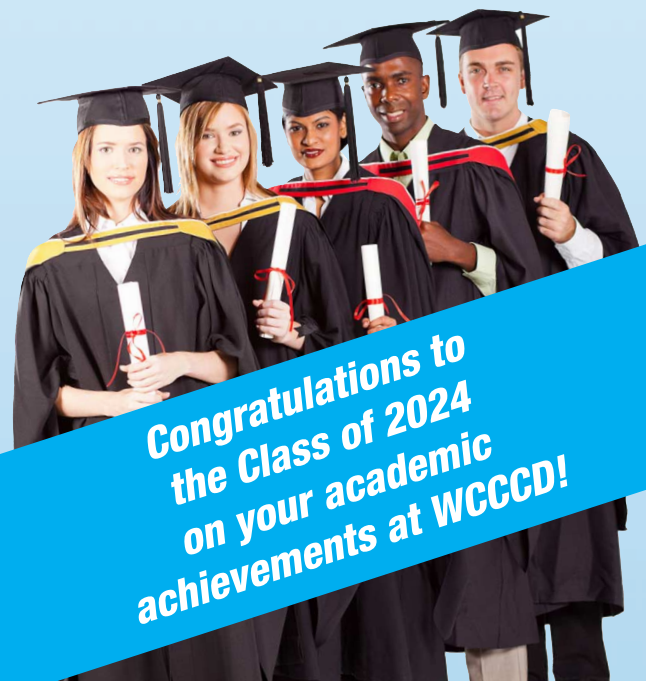
