Focus Electives (6 credits)

Take two courses from ONE area on the focus elective sheet. You may NOT double count any course used for General Education requirements I through VI or for your concentration. Honors Program Foreign Language requirement will fulfill focus electives.

Major Courses: General Business (18 credits)

In addition to the requirements for the BBA degree, the concentration in general business requires 18 additional credits in business, including at least 15 credits in courses numbered 300 or higher with the exception of business departmental credit. Honors Program will substitute HON/BUS 496 (4 cr) for BUS 394 (3 cr). Class descriptions are listed on another sheet.
